Senator Chambers moves that we reconsider our action on LB 63. That will be laid over.

Senator Lewis asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 108 in the Legislative Journal. (See Page 640 of the Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Carsten to whom we referred LB 294 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File with amendments. (See Pages 640 and 641 of the Legislative Journal.)
