SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 90 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. A machine vote's been requested. The motion is the advancement of LB 90 to E & R for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Now, Senator Wesely, we have 90A.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I move 90A to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion and the second. All those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R for Engrossment say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. LB 90 is advanced. The Clerk has some things on his desk, and then I have some guests I'd like to introduce.
