SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I move LB 322 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 322 for...to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 132.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move LB 132 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: 132. I'm sorry, 322. No...

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, we're on 132.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 132 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Next bill, LB 425. Any E & R amendments to 425?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, move that LB 425 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion, say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. LB 130.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 130 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion and the second. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried and the bill is advanced. That completes Select File. Underneath the north balcony two guests of Senator Maresh, Ray Rempe of Milligan and Darrel Malesker of Hastings. Would you stand so that we may recognize you? Ready for General File, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I am.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, LB 25.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 25 was a bill introduced by Senator Walter George of the 16th. (Read by title LB 25.) The bill was read for the first time on January 4 of this year. It was referred to the Agriculture and Environment Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are no amendments
