SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have anything else to read in?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready for LB 435 on General File?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 435 was a bill introduced by the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title LB 435.) The bill was read on January 17th. It was referred to the Constitutional Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel, do you have the Committee amendments to 435?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Yes. Mr. Speaker and members of the body, the Committee amendments, as you can see in your bill book, strike the word "game" and insert "wild animal", and that is for definitional purposes. "Migratory" in the same manner. And also inserts "bona fide farmer or rancher who owns or leases farm or ranch land who actually resides upon such land, or a member of the immediate family of such farmer or rancher who also resides upon such land, while hunting on the home farm or ranch." I don't know if we can avoid talking about
