SENATOR KELLY: Well, we want to debate advancing the bill. That was no closing. That was answering a question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I thought I called you to close. Do you...

SENATOR KELLY: I've been had. I'll quit.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 223 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Okay. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced, and the Clerk has some items on his desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all, Senator Dworak asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 133 in the Journal. (Amendment to LB 133 may be found on Page 697 of the Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator...your Committee on Business and Labor whose Chairman is Senator Maresh to whom we referred LB 489 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments. (See Page 697 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance gives notice of public hearing in Room 2230. (See Page 697 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have Attorney General Opinions...one addressed to Senator Schmit, the second to Senator Nichol, and the third to Senator Wesely. Those will be inserted in the Journal. (See Pages 697 through 703 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, finally I have a new Resolution...LR 19 introduced by Senators Maresh, George, Lewis, Lamb, Kelly and Schmit...Duis, excuse me. (LR 19 may be found on Pages 703 and 704 of the Legislative Journal as read by the Clerk.)
