SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt LR 17 found on page 654 of the Journal. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on LR 17. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, on the adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The resolution is adopted and there is a unanimous consent request from Senator Sieck that he be added as the co-sponsor of the resolution. Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. Senator Koch, do you want to take up your motion on LB 126?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, the committee heard LB 126, but before moving beyond a certain point, we asked for an Attorney General's opinion whether or not if there is an error made in the certification of a teacher and there has to be an additional filing fee, whether or not the Department of Public Instruction could forego that additional payment due to an error either by the Department or some other institution. The Attorney General has advised us that the Department can do this without such a law. That is the reason we are asking that LB 126 be withdrawn.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to withdraw LB 126. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to withdraw LB 126, have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the bill is withdrawn. Senator Schmit, are you ready to take up LR 19 found on page 703? The Clerk will read the resolution.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 19. Read.
