LB 130, 132, 322.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of the law relative to the procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 130 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Page 846 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 130 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 132.

CLERK: (Read LB 132.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 132 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 1 nay, 4 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Page 847 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 132 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 322.

CLERK: (Read LB 322.)

PRESIDENT: Is everybody at their seats, and having listened constitutionally to this bill, we're ready to vote. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 322 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Page 848 of the Legislative Journal.)
