federals. What this bill proposes to do is to allow these state savings and loans the same privileges as the federals are in order that they may maintain a state charter and the same types of advantages. In addition to this, I will have an amendment that I will offer at a later time which clarifies some language as it relates to mortgage deeds and mortgages. This bill in the past the Legislature has accepted as being reasonable and I see nothing very controversial about it so I ask for the advancement of LB 154 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion on the measure? The motion is the advancement of LB 154 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 154 to E & R for review. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Next bill is LB 57.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 57 was a bill introduced by Senator Jerry Koch. Title read. The bill was read for the first time on January 4. It was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Koch's Education Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 57. For those of you who may not be familiar with it, it deals with the Educational Service Units and their privilege of performing certain kinds of purchasing. There were several bills that were brought in on this issue trying to define very specifically what they will purchase, how they shall purchase and to what quantity and even to specify the kinds of material they can indeed purchase in cooperation with other Educational Service Units and the schools of the State of Nebraska. So what 57 is is an omnibus piece of legislation that tries to include the positive features of several bills. The committee has adopted those amendments and placed them in 57 as a carrier. I move for the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments to LB 57. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.
