Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation whose Chairman is Senator Reutzel to whom we referred LB 553 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File with amendments. Mr. President, your Committee on Agriculture and Environment whose Chairman is Senator Schmit to whom we referred LB 326 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File. 399 to General File, and LB 62 indefinitely postponed, and those are signed by Senator Schmit, Chairman.
