Alright, we'll proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with the reading of LB 223 on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 223.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 223 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote. Senator Kelly wants to vote. Go ahead.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 4 nays, 3 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Record vote may be found on Page 929 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 223 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 245.

CLERK: (Read LB 245.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Merz, for what purpose do you rise? Thank you, proceed with the reading.

CLERK: (Continues reading LB 245.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 245 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
