PRESIDENT: You may read some matters in, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis asks unanimous consent to have his name added to LR 26 as co-introducer.

Mr. President, new resolution, LR 29, introduced by the Business and Labor Committee. (Read LR 29 as found on page 974 of the Legislative Journal.) That will properly be laid over, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir. Anything further?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, Senator Newell offers explanation of vote. Senator Dworak asks unanimous consent to print amendments to 164, Senator Warner to 577, Senator Lewis to 227, and Senator Murphy to LB 42.

Mr. President, your committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance, whose chairman is Senator DeCamp to whom we referred LB 415 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments, signed, Senator DeCamp.

Mr. President, your committee on Urban Affairs whose chairman is Senator George to whom we referred LB 136 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File with amendments.

Your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs whose chairman is Senator Keyes to whom we referred LB 195 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File, 329 to General File, 345 to General File, 331 to General File with amendments, 387 to General File with amendments, and 429 indefinitely postponed, signed, Senator Keyes, Chairman.
