CLERK: Senator Lamb continues to vote no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Board is open, Senator Fitzgerald.

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald continues to vote aye. Senator Koch voting aye. Senator Labedz voting aye. Senator Keyes voting aye.
