CLERK: Mr. President, LB 495. Title read. The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this bill put in the works at the request of the City of Omaha. There have been quite a few problems with people having elections voting on different TV franchise. The city thinks that they can't do it by a vote of the City Council and are simply asking permission to do so.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? The motion is to advance LB 495 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? This is advancing LB 495 to E & R for review. We are voting to advance LB 495 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Go ahead and read in.
