PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by Chaplain.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler, Fowler and Kremer would like to be excused all day. Senator Lewis until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Record the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Mr. President, on Page 1096 of the amendment, correct the spelling of the word "telephone".

PRESIDENT: Alright, any notices, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed LB 23 and recommend that same be replaced on Select File with amendments. Signed, Senator Wesely, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: We're ready for Final Reading, so the Sergeant at Arms will secure the Chamber. All legislators will return to their desks, and we will...as soon as that occurs, all nonlegislative personnel leave the floor...we will commence with Final Reading for today.
