CLERK: Mr. President, LB 484. Title read. The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The bill was advanced to General File with committee amendments. In addition, Mr. President, I have amendments to the committee amendments offered by Senator Newell.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, do you have amendments to the committee amendments?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I do.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Where are they, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: They are not in the Journal. Would you like me to read them, Senator?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendments read as follows: Read Newell amendment offered on page 1130, Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you move adoption of the amendments?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I do.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, would you like to explain them please?

SENATOR NEWELL: Basically, they just further clarify the committee amendments. If we could adopt these, then I would explain the full committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Newell amendments to the committee amendments to LB 484. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Newell, would you like to discuss the committee amendments as amended?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, Mr. President. Basically what we are doing here is there has been a prohibition against sheriff's department personnel from being active in campaigns. It would also prevent sheriff's department personnel from even running for the office of sheriff. Now there
