SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 524. Senator Reutzel, your light's still on. Do you want to talk? All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed no. This is the advancement of LB 524 to E & R for Review. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.
