LB 42, 220

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. LB 42 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. Now according to Senator DeCamp's motion, the motion is to return LB 42 to Select File for the specific amendment, the emergency clause. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill has been returned. Now, Senator DeCamp, do you want to move the adoption of the emergency clause?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the emergency clause. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the emergency clause is added to LB 42. Senator Wesely, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I move that LB 42 be readvanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. LB 42 is readvanced to E & R for engrossment. Next motion concerns LB 220. Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 220 be brought back from final reading for a specific amendment. Do you want me to explain the amendment?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR KEYES: The amendment just simply says that if such bank charter is located in a city or village, then for transfer outside of the county in which it is located, it seems that the Banking Department brought it to my attention and I have talked to him about it, Mr. Barry Lake, they have issued a banking permit for a bank to be constructed outside of the City of Hickman. They are in the process, we hope, of issuing a permit for a bank to be constructed outside of the city limits of Papillion. The law is not exactly clear and they are actually permitting banks to be
