CLERK: (Read record vote as found on Pages 1197 and 1198 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 476 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 477.

CLERK: (Read LB 477.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 477 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on Pages 1198 and 1199 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting and 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 477 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 509.

CLERK: (Read LB 509.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 509 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
