LB 176, 196, 200

SENATOR MARESH: But there is no difference in bringing it back to Select File or leaving it there until 250 catches up. See, it has the same matter in it. Can we just hold it up until 250...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well I will try to see that 250 moves as rapidly as possible but please don't bracket bills because we are simply... You are going to have everything fouled up on that board.

SENATOR MARESH: Thank you, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. Speaker, I will yield to Senator Koch then.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, in the good faith, I visited with Senator Maresh. I would withdraw my motion to strike the enactment clause and in lieu of that I would move that we would pass over 176 until a later time and possibly several of us can work together and see if we can't resolve the issue.

PRESIDENT: I think with what the Speaker has said the Speaker will work with you and Senator Maresh to accomplish that. Speaker Marvel, is that correct? You will work with them to that extent? So we will just pass over LB 176 for today then and a motion has been officially withdrawn and is so noted on the record. The Clerk, and I remind you we are still on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 196.

CLERK: (Read LB 196 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 196 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote on LB 196 as found on page 1227 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting and 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 196 passes on Final Reading and the Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 200.

CLERK: (Read LB 200 on Final Reading.)
