CLERK: Mr. President, new bill, 589, introduced by the Appropriations Committee. (Read by title for the first time LB 589.) Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to suspend the rules so as to place LB 589 directly on General File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of that request vote aye, opposed vote no. This is to place the new bill on General File. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? This is the Appropriations Committee's request to put the bill on General File. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to place on General File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is on General File. The Clerk has some items to read in to the agenda and then we will adjourn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 227. Senator Koch asks unanimous consent to withdraw his name as cointroducer from LR 30.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, new resolution, LR 44, introduced by Senator Kelly. (Read LR 44 as found on Pages 1251 and 1252 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be properly referred to the Executive Board.

Mr. President, LR 45 introduced by Senator Warner...or excuse me, Senator Hefner. (Read LR 45 as found on Page 1252 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be properly laid over.

Mr. President, Senator Wesely and Warner ask unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 327, Senator Hefner to 101A.

Mr. President, your Committee on Public Works gives notice of hearing in Room 1515 for April 11. Your Committee on Appropriations gives notice of meeting in Room 1003 on April 10.
