SENATOR HABERMAN: Then I move to raise the Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Call is raised. Record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, motion is carried. Senator Schmit, do you wish to bring up your motion tomorrow on LB 321?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I do, please, and I ask that those amendments be printed in the Journal today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If there is no objection, so ordered. We are now ready for a Committee on Committees report. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, Mr. President. Will the Clerk please give the page number?

CLERK: 1325, Senator.

SENATOR MARSH: The following names were heard by the Committee on Committees and are recommended for consideration for confirmation: Ralph Crowl, State Electrical Board; James D. Keenan, State Highway Commission; Joan Nelson, Nebraska Art Council; E. A. Olson, Environmental Control Council; Loren G. Olsson, Nebraska Arts Council; and Wallace Richardson, Nebraska Arts Council. There were no negative votes. I move for the adoption of this report.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the Committee on Committees report as found on page 1325 of the Journal. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the report.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the report is adopted. Do you have some things to read in?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Retuzel asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 221; Senator Schmit to print amendments to LB 321.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We have two bills on Special Order. The first one is LB 568, Public Works Committee.
