SPEAKER MARVEL: For the benefit of those who are in both the north and south balconies, some of you may have an agenda of today's activities, we will be on Final Reading for approximately an hour and a half. The Constitution of the state indicates that every bill must be read on Final Reading by the Clerk. Most of the legislators have already gone through these bills, but the Constitution indicates that the legislators must be in their seats while the Clerk reads the bills. So within a short time we will go into Final Reading. It may be that you have some other activities that you'd like to undertake and then come back at approximately 11:00 when we will have a Mother of the Year presentation, and also then move into a Special Order, which has to do with judge's salaries. Now, will all legislators please take their seats in preparation for Final Reading. We cannot proceed on Final Reading until all legislators are in their seats. The first bill on Final Reading is LB 65. Is there a motion on the desk, Mr. Clerk?
