SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker, members of the House, we spent considerable time, the committee did, the Judiciary Committee did in looking at something that we felt like that would come up that would be a...would pertain to the concept of the Hays report as well as a reasonable salary for the various categories of judges and I think Senator Nichol's amendment is very good. It is in line with some of the members of the Judiciary Committee and therefore I support this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, just conversationalizing with a bunch of the members and other interested parties and this seems to be the consensus of what we ought to do about this moment in time and what will fly, so let's get it over with.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. I see more than five hands. Shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The question before the House is, shall debate cease? Record.
