SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The bill is advanced. The Clerk can read some things into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 285.

Mr. President, new bill, 378A, introduced by Senator Nichol. (Read by title for the first time as found on page 1501 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose chairman is Senator Cullan to whom is referred LB 525 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments.
