PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 328 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote may be found on Page 1556 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 37 ayes, 2 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 8 present and not voting, Mr. President.
