SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I move that LB 345 be advanced to E & R...or to Final Reading, E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of advancement of the bill... we're advancing it to Final Reading.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Final Reading, vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the advancement of 345 to Final Reading. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Chair is going to ask for a vote once more and then ask to have the vote verified. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 19 nays on the motion to return to Final Reading, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The bill is not advanced. The Chair now...we'll go back to Final Reading and read LB 353 on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 353.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote which may be found on Page 1605 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, and 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill passed. The next bill on Final Reading is LB 396.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 396.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote which may be found on Page 1606 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
