LB 87, 241

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Are we supposed to be here on Final Reading?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes. We're still on Final....

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Why do you have to have a roll call?

SPEAKER MARVEL: There is a request....if one member requests it, we can have a roll call vote. This is on a motion. This isn't on a Final Reading vote. This is on a motion to bring the bill back from Final Reading to Select File for the purpose of striking the enacting clause. That's the amendment we are dealing with.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I think I made my....

SPEAKER MARVEL: You made your point, now would you please record your presence?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The roll call vote. Senator Chambers, I think everybody is here now. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken which may be found on Pages 1611 and 1612 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators please be in their seats. Hold up the count until then. All legislators please be in their seats. Okay.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 28 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. We're now ready to vote on LB 87 on Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote may be found on Pages 1612 and 1613 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 18 nays, 2 excused and not voting and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 241.

CLERK: (Read on Final LB 241.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of the law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those
