SENATOR CULLAN: Okay, lets call them in.

PRESIDENT: All right let them report the votes, we will accept votes.

CLERK: Senator Koch voting aye. Senator Newell voting aye. Senator Wagner voting aye. Senator Hasebroock voting aye. Senator Keyes voting aye. Senator DeCamp voting aye. Senator Nichol voting...Senator Nichol had voted aye. Senator Landis voting aye. Senator Duis voting aye.

SENATOR CULLAN: Raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Okay, report the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to reconsider Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion carries. The bill is reconsidered. The Clerk suggests that while we are under Call and we have everybody here that is going to be here that we read the bill. Mr. Speaker, do you object to that? We will proceed with the Final Reading of LB 174A. Proceed with the Final Reading of LB 174A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read LB 174A.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall LB 174A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. This will require 30 votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: Read vote. 30 ayes, 8 nays, 5 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1647 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 174A passes on Final Reading. Senator DeCamp moves to raise the Call. Any objection? Hearing none the Call is raised. We will revert now to LB 505. I understand that Senator Haberman is going to...is there a withdrawal? Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw my.....

PRESIDENT: Your motion to return. It is withdrawn, Senator Haberman. We will proceed then with the motion on the desk by Senator Simon. Mr. Clerk, do you want to read the motion?
