SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record your presence please. Okay, record.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have some items to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Just briefly, Mr. President. Senator Koch would like to be excused tomorrow in the morning.

Your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined LB 174 and find the same correctly enrolled and LB 174A correctly enrolled.

SPEAKER MARVEL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am about to sign and do sign LB 174 and LB 174A. The first item of business is item #8 which is Select File and the first bill is LB 216, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 216.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 216.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Reutzel now moves to amend the bill and those amendments are on page 1592 of the Journal. 1592.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, briefly all this amendment does is to ensure that we do not go beyond the original intent of the bill. There seemed to have been a problem, some question as to how broad this may have applied. The Department of Banking and the Banking Association got together and they both agreed on it. Everyone concerned has agreed that this really tacks it down so that it doesn't go beyond its original intent and I would move the adoption of the amendments.
