LB 65, 394

SPEAKER MARVEL: Pat. All legislators must be in their seats during Final Reading. Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: (Continued reading LB 394 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1682 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting and 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Senator Simon, your light is on.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, members of the body, while I thought there was a break in the action and some people were hungry, I've got my ice cream truck parked outside. So if anybody needs any ice cream...

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will read LB 65 on Final Reading. Pardon?

CLERK: I have a motion on the desk, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to return LB 65.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, this was a funny...one of those funny things I was going to tease Senator Keyes about but not a lot of people are smiling right now and I don't think it is in the proper mood so I would like to withdraw that motion. SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready to read LB 65 on Final Reading? Senator Newell asked unanimous consent to withdraw the motion. Hearing no objections... Do you object? So ordered.

CLERK: (Read LB 65 on Final Reading.)
