LB 75, 344A, 378A

SENATOR STONEY: I would like to, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is, shall the Legislature go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. The Clerk is authorized to accept votes.

CLERK: Senator Fowler voting aye. Senator Chambers voting aye. Senator Wesely voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised. The Clerk will announce the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is 378A.

CLERK: (Read by title 378A.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, this is the sexual-sociopath bill that is in the progress of going across the board, and should it pass we will need an appropriation of \$1500 for the purpose of paying for expenses for a committee that would work in regard to that. I move for the adoption, or passage of 378A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 378A to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 75, Senator Nichol.
