SENATOR NICHOL: The question is the Schmit amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Reutzel had an amendment to the bill but I understand that he wishes to withdraw that.
