LB 332, 387, 42

PRESIDENT: LB 252 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 332.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 332.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 332 pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 40 ayes, no nays, 6 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting. Vote appears on page 1892 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 382 passes on Final Reading. (sic). The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 387.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Starts to read 387.

PRESIDENT: Is there a motion on the desk? I think there is isn't there Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Supposed to have a motion on 387.

PRESIDENT: Is there a motion on the desk? There is supposed to be a motion on this. 387.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr....

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I would ask that we pass over 387 for the time being. I thought that I had filed an amendment to it, but I haven't, and I will try and locate it.

PRESIDENT: All right, Speaker Marvel is that...we will go on to the next bill then, fine. All right. We will proceed then with LB 42. Speaker Marvel, the next one has a problem too, because Senator DeCamp has brought it to our attention that it needs an A bill. They need some more information, Senator DeCamp said. So, I presume that that should be put over too. Is that agreeable?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes. How long? Tomorrow? Is that all we need an A bill. Okay, if there are no objections we will pass over it until tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will pass over both.
