SPEAKER MARVEL: Is that it?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The next item of business is LB 357.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 357.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: There we go. Okay. I move the E & R amendments to LB 357.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have amendments offered by Senator Schmit. Those amendments are on Page 1403 of the Journal.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendments, and the amendments, Mr. President, very simply transfers the administrative authority from the Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Board of Regents, and the amendment also provides that those states that are participating which do not fill their quota may bargain with other states to fill that quota. I move for the adoption of the amendments.
