LB 596, 594

Select for specific amendment. All in favor of the return of the bill vote aye, opposed no. The motion is to return the bill. Have you all voted? We are voting to return the bill to Select File for the purpose of adopting the Lewis amendment, LB 596. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the adoption of the amendment vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the adoption of the Lewis amendment to LB 596. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR LEWIS: Well, Mr. President, I don't want to go through the unpleasant process of a Call of the House but I could use one more vote. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, do you wish to readvance LB 596?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 596 be readvanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is readvanced. Are we ready to go to LB 591? While we are waiting for that, from Senator Maresh's District in the South balcony are 11 third and fourth grade students from District 163, Western, Nebraska. Patty Gass is the teacher. Are you in the South balcony? Hold up your hands so we can see where you are. Don't lean on the balcony for your own welfare. Okay, we will take up an amendment to LB 594.
