SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. 378A is advanced. I noted an interesting article this morning on the procedure that we just completed. Senator Newell, are you ready for 345?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, I don't know how this bill always comes up on Fridays when people are gone but, no, I am not ready for 345.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 53, 65 and 82 are ready for your signature.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a new resolution, LR 119: Read. That will be referred to the Executive Board, Mr. President. (See pages 2075-2077, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am about to sign and do sign LR 53, LR 65, LR 82. The Clerk will read the title to LB 312.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 312.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 312.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp now has amendments to the bill and they are on page 1716 of the Journal.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Is this 312? Okay, as you recall, this was the bill on insurance involving automobile dealers, home-owners policies, Sears, Montgomery Ward and everything and then at the critical time there was a disagreement. So the amendment settles all the agreements and I have the authority to say that the Director of Insurance accepts this and is satisfied with it and every major group that was involved ranging from real estate people to automobile dealers to
