We have run into problems with that heretofore and I think that it is a point that we really need to take into consideration also. Without any further comments Mr. President, I would urge this body to adopt the amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the adoption of the Carsten amendment to LB 138. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 17 nays 1 excused and not voting, 6 present and not voting Mr. President. Vote appears on page 2119 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 138 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried, the bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goodrich wishes to withdraw his motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The next item is 138A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Carsten moves to return 138A to Select File for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I would move that we bring 138A back and amend it with the amendment that reflects what we did in 138. What it will do is strike 730,164 and insert 184,131. It will also on page 2, line 8 strike 6 and insert 5, page 2 lines 9 and 10 strike 527,175 and insert 221,740. I would move that it be returned for the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, no nays on a motion to return Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried the bill is returned. Senator Carsten.
