LB 444A, 500, 500A

CLERK: (Read title to LB 444A.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote was taken which may be found on Page 2157 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 1 nay, 6 present and not voting and 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with emergency clause attached. Underneath the south balcony it's my privilege to introduce the father-in-law and mother-in-law of Senator Dworak, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Koesh. Will you folks stand so we can say hello to you? The Clerk will read LB 500 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title to LB 500.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass, LB 500, on Final Reading? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Clerk, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote was taken which may be found on Pages 2157 and 2158 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 26 ayes, 19 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 500A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title to LB 500A.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Senator Duis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DUIS: This requires thirty votes doesn't it? For the A bill?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes. Yes.
