that initial property to get it back on the tax roll of course defeats that, and I'm assuming that the pay back period could have been for less than the fifteen years plus the accelerated receipts, which will then be diverted and still kept off the tax roll. But I further would point out to you that that section says that money may also be used for loans. Now if this is some way of prepaying it by providing that that excess money can be loaned to some other purpose, then I fail to see it. I ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Murphy amendment to LB 158. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Murphy. Clerk, record the vote.
