Fitzgerald, Senator Fitzgerald. Record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 15 nays on the adoption of Senator Fitzgerald's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, are you ready...one of you, who wants to close? Senator Newell, do you want to close now?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Vickers and myself are still in agreement on this rule change. His personal attacks on me were unfair, but at the same time we still have the same purpose in mind and that is the adoption of this rule. I think the rule is very simple. I think it should be well understood. The purpose here is to close a major loophole, to strengthen the committee system and I think that it does it without any great imposition to the individual or to the committee. For that reason I would hope that you would adopt the rule.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Newell and Vickers rule change as discussed. All those in favor of the rule change vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on Item #5 on your rule change sheets. This is the Newell and Vickers rule change. Have you all voted? Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Are there many people gone today? Well...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 5 nays on adoption of the proposed rule change.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, motion carried. The rule change is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President if I may, your committee on E & R respectfully reports that we have carefully examined LB 467 and find the same correctly enrolled, 398 correctly enrolled, 380A, 380, and 357 all correctly enrolled. Signed, Senator Wesley.

SPEAKER MARVEL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I'm about to sign and do sign LB 467, 398, 380A, 380, 357.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk respectfully reports that she has on this day presented to the Governor the following bills: 80, 216, 216A, 172, 172A, 162, 149, 107, 312, 251, and 348 and 321.
