PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Chaplain Palmer with a prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. President, I move that we adopt temporary rules until such time that a motion is made to adopt the permanent rules.
