PRESIDENT: All right, you want a roll call vote then. Senator Powers, are you here? Senator Chronister, I believe you are here. Senator Chronister, would you register your presence. Senator Cullan, Senator Schmit, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Clark...Senator Clark, Cullan, Schmit, Fitzgerald. Here comes Senator Fitzgerald. Senator Cullan, Senator Clark and Senator Schmit are the ones that we are waiting for. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, how many are gone? We have eight missing as I counted before.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan, Senator Clark and Senator Schmit. That will be five absent. Here comes Senator Clark.

SENATOR NEWELL: I think Senator Cullan is gone for the day. So if Senator Schmit would come back, I would go ahead with the roll call.

PRESIDENT: All right. If the Sergeant at Arms can find Senator Schmit why we can proceed with the vote. Senator Schmit is on his way according to the Sergeant at Arms, so we will soon get under way with the roll call. Here he is, so ready then, Senator Newell, to proceed with the roll call vote.

CLERK: Go ahead?

PRESIDENT: Yes, we are ready. Senator Schmit, do you want to push your...okay, we are ready.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 351 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The bill does not advance for the second time. The motion is, Senator Nichol, to raise the Call. Seeing no objection, the Call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, very quickly, your committee on Public Health and Welfare gives notice of public hearing for January 28 and 29. Signed by Senator Cullan. Senator DeCamp asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 405 in the Legislative Journal.
