LB 35, 781, 962, 963

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, I believe, Mr. President, I will have to have a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson requests a Call of the House. All right, those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will secure all members, bring them back in the chamber. All members will be at their desks. All unauthorized personnel will leave the floor. All members of the Legislature will register your presence. The House is under Call. Senator Sieck, do you want to register your presence? Senator Haberman, do you want to register your presence? Senator Goodrich is not... and Senator Dworak. Senator Dworak and Senator Goodrich. Sergeant at Arms, we are looking for Senator Goodrich and Senator Dworak, Goodrich and Dworak. Here is Senator Dworak so we have got one. All right, Senator Johnson, do you want to take votes or do...?

SENATOR JOHNSON: I would ask for a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: All right, do you want to wait for Senator Goodrich?

SENATOR JOHNSON: We can go ahead and commence.

PRESIDENT: All right, go ahead with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 405 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion failed. LB 35 does not advance. Go on to...well LB 35 stays...read the...the Clerk will read a few matters in at this point.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to have his name added as co-introducer to LB 962 and 963.

Mr. President, Senator Stoney moves to withdraw LB 781. That will be properly laid over.

Your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose chairman is Senator Cullan to whom is referred LB 641 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File, (Signed) Senator Cullan, Chairman.
