LB 261, 284

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 284.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 284. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 284 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move that LB 284 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 284 to E & R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing LB 284...Senator Kremer, excuse me.

SENATOR KREMER: I am going to request that 204, 254 be passed over. The Department... (Machine malfunctions.)

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will bring all members into the room to their seats. All legislators will go to their desks. All nonauthorized personnel will leave the floor. All legislators will register your presence at this time. Senator Kelly, will you hit your button so we know you are here. Senator Schmit. Senator Reutzel. Here he is. That is probably all that are going to show. Are we going to accept call in votes, Senator Hoagland?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, why don't we have call in votes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Reutzel voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Motion is the advancement.

CLERK: Senator Dworak voting no; Senator Powers voting aye; Senator Wagner voting aye; Senator Barrett voting aye; Senator Warner voting no; Senator Carsten voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers, we are voting on the advance of LB 261. The House is under Call. What do you want to do, Senator Hoagland?
