CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion carries and LB 828 is withdrawn. Senator Wesely has a guest. The Chair would like to introduce Pat Egan from Lincoln under the North balcony. Pat, welcome to the Legislature. Barb Wagner under the North balcony and we also have Glen Davidson from Syracuse under the South balcony, Senator Carsten's guest. Would you stand and be recognized. Welcome, Mr. Davidson. Now we will take up the withdrawal motion of Senator Stoney on LB 781.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this proposal was introduced on behalf of the Davis Teacher Placement Service in Omaha. Subsequent to the bills introduction it has been learned that the Nebraska Personnel Association will be working in conjunction with the Labor Department this summer. The impact on present rules dealing personnel agencies here in the State of Nebraska and what is attempted to be accomplished in this bill can be addressed at that time. For that reason I ask that the bill be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on Senator Stoney's motion? If not, all those in favor of withdrawing LB 781 vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and LB 781 is withdrawn. Anything to read into the record, Mr. Clerk?
