PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, the committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 44 and recommend that same be placed on Select File.
