LB 374, 535, 629, 703, 986.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: We are ready for LB 374 on Select File and the Clerk will bring us up to date on that.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 374 has no E & R amendments. I do have a motion to indefinitely postpone offered by Senator Chambers. That would properly lay the bill over, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: That was just put on the desk today.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: So the bill will lay over at this time. All right, proceed then....that takes care of LB 374. Proceed then with LB 535.

CLERK: Mr. President, real quickly, if I may, your committee on Urban Affairs whose Chairman is Senator George instructs me....to whom was referred LB 986 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments; LB 629 advanced to General File and LB 703 to General File with amendments. (Signed) Senator George as Chairman. (See page 487 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: All right, now 535.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 535, there are E & R amendments pending, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 535.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments on LB 535. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 535 signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted on LB 535.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a motion by Senator Hoagland to amend the bill. I believe copies have been distributed to the membership. It reads as follows: (Read Hoagland amendment as found on page 488 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hoagland.
