SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and fellow members, I don't think a long close is necessary. I think the question is well understood. If you are in agreement with some of the provisions or with the provisions in LB 628 regarding the training and the other sections, I would urge your adoption of this amendment, if your only concern with LB 628 is the dollar figures.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Vickers amendment to 628. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays on adoption of Senator Vickers amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I move that LB 628 be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is the advancement of the bill. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, very quickly. I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Lewis on LB 652. That will be inserted in the Journal. (See pages 668 and 669 of the Legislative Journal.) Corrected committee statement for LB 618.
