LB 108

SENATOR NEWELL: Is mine the only light?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No.

SENATOR NEWELL: I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay. Shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Okay, record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Hoagland to close.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I will waive closing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. The motion before the House is the reconsideration of LB 108. 30 votes are needed. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the reconsideration of LB 108. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would ask for a Call of the House, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Legislature is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor and record your presence. At the moment there are five excused. Senator Keyes, Senator Rumery, Senator Beutler, Senator Kahle, Senator DeCamp, Senator Haberman, Senator Marsh, Senator Kelly. Senator Haberman and Senator Marsh are not accounted for. Do you want to proceed with the roll call?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I have seen both Senators Haberman and Marsh here this morning, Mr. Speaker. I know they are in the building. I would like to ask for a roll call but I wonder if we might take a minute or two to see if we can find them first.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Sergeant at Arms, we are seeking Senator Haberman and Senator Marsh. Please find Senator Haberman, Mr. Sergeant at Arms. We are under a Call of the House. All legislators must be in their seats. All legislators are to be in
