general fund appropriation for the inspection. I would move, Mr. President, the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 959 to E & R for review. Senator Keyes, do you wish to be recognized? Your light is on.

SENATOR KEYES: Well only one question of Senator Warner. Senator Warner, this fee will not be paid by the insurance companies. Will it? It will be paid by the owners of the boilers?

SENATOR WARNER: It is paid by the owner of the boiler. Now in the case of where the insurance company does the inspection I assume that they charge the owner of the boiler as a part of their insurance fee in some fashion for the inspection.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of advancement of the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 959. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. LB 663.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 663.) The bill was read on January 10 of this year. It was referred to the Education Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are no amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner. 663, Senator Warner. 663.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, 663 was introduced by the committee as a result of the fact that the Displaced Homemakers Act that was enacted a couple of years ago had an automatic sunset provision that it was to expire June 30 of 1980 and it was a somewhat in depth report made upon the activity of this agency since it was established, the number of people served, the kind of activities that they had and the committee did vote to introduce the bill to continue its existence. There is one change in it. The original bill was restricted to two pilot multipurpose service centers to be located at some point in the state and that limitation of the two pilot projects was stricken and the limitation on the number that might ever occur would be contingent upon the level of appropriation that the Legislature would approve for the activity. As I understand it, there is one in Omaha now and one in Grand Island. It was indicated to us and perhaps the standing committee has additional information but it was indicated to us there was some consideration of expanded as is
